Directions: (The meet location is on Knox Road, **not** the main barn side on Buffalo Road).

*All buses will park on Knox Road facing East. Buses must enter the race area via Gypsy Lane from 20A/Quaker Road or Willardshire Road to Knox Road.

*Spectator Parking will be at the East End (closer to the village) of the Knox Park Soccer Fields on Knox Road. Spectator Parking will only be accessible only from Buffalo Rd/Rt 16 via Gray Street to Knox Rd traveling West.

*Handicap Parking will be at the West-Equestrian End near the Start/Finish Areas accessible only from Gypsy Lane or Willardshire Road to Knox Road.

Parking directions will be sent with last minute meet directions prior to the invitational.
