- \$70 for either boys <u>or</u> girls teams (FroshSoph/Varsity "B"/Varsity included)
- \$25 per FroshSoph/Varsity "B"/Varsity individual without entering any other race

**Teams must have three (3) or more runners in order to avoid the individual entry fee.

Directions: Interstate 90 (Thruway) to exit 55 then take Ridge Road (East). Turn right onto Orchard Park Road (Route 240) and follow up to East-West Road. Go left onto East-West Road and continue about three miles (past Union Road) until you reach the park, which will be the second park on your left. Drop off and parking directions will be distributed as we approach the date of the competition.

<u>Rules</u>: This competition is governed by the National Federation of High Schools, the New York State Public High Schools Athletic Association, Section VI Athletics, and the Erie County Interscholastic Conference. Jewelry, uniform, and electronics rules are in effect and will be enforced. The Games Committee will be comprised of the head official, another coach to be determined, and the Event Director. Any protests must be clearly written and explained before given to anyone on the Games Committee.

Entry Information: All races must have a minimum of five (5) runners to be eligible for team scoring. There will be a maximum of seven (7) runners in all Varsity races. An unlimited number of competitors may participate in the team scored freshmen/sophomore races or the team scored junior/senior Varsity "B" races. All freshmen or sophomores not Varsity race caliber can only participate in the freshmen/sophomore races. All juniors or seniors not Varsity race caliber can only participate in the Varsity "B" junior/senior races. Runners who are typically Varsity caliber should not be participating in any other races. Any 7th or 8th grader participating in this competition on either level must have been approved through the NYSPHSAA Athletic Placement process.

<u>The attached entry form should accompany the payment</u>. Be sure to complete it legibly and carefully. The determination of divisions will be based on school enrollment data compiled by the NYSPHSAA for this season.

<u>Results Information</u>: A timing system will be employed as the primary mode of producing results. Primary results will be finalized by manually recording bib numbers in the order of finish through the chute. A video of each race may back up each set of results. There may be a secondary video back up. A copy of the race results will be posted as the races conclude.

<u>Course Information</u>: 99% grassy, rolling trail course (almost half of course is raced on the trails) that is partially viewer friendly and generally accessible. Mile markers can be easily located on the course. 1/4" or 3/8" spikes are strongly recommended.

<u>Commemorative Apparel</u>: A limited number of t-shirts produced by **Winged Foot** will also be sold for a cost of \$15 each.
